Janet A. Harkness holds the Donald and Shirley Clifton Chair in Survey Science at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL) where she is Director of the Survey Research and Methodology Program and the UNL Gallup Research Center. She is a Senior Research Scientist at Gesis-ZUMA, Mannheim, Germany. As member of the Central Co-ordinating Team of the European Social Survey (ESS), she has responsibility for the ESS Translation Guidelines. She gained a Masters in Comparative Medieval Studies from Edinburgh University, Scotland and a doctorate in English Literature and Linguistics, Cultural Anthropology and Phonetics from Albert-Ludwigs University, Freiburg, Germany. She has pioneered research into translated version production and assessment in multilingual survey research. Her current research focuses on the interface between instrument design and other language version comparability. She has published, presented, and taught on numerous aspects of cross-cultural survey research and communication. She became a Descartes Laureate in 2005.
