

Loosveldt, Geert

Geert Loosveldt is professor at the department of Sociology of the Catholic University of Leuven. His research focuses on research methodology in general and evaluation of survey data quality in particular. He received a Ph.D. in the Social Sciences in 1986 with a research project about the effect of an interviewer training on the quality of survey data. Evaluation of interviewer effects and the causes and impact of non response error are other of his research topics. He teaches courses about social statistics and social science research methodology.

He published in *Public Opinion Quarterly*, *International Journal of Public Opinion Research*, *Survey Methodology*, *Quality and Quantity*, *Sociological Methods & Research*, *Journal of Official Statistics* and *Social Science Computer Review*.

He is a frequently asked consultant in survey research projects. He was appointed by the National Research Fund as the national co-ordinator of the European Social Survey in Flanders and he is also a member of the steering committee of the Annual Flemish Survey.
