Katja Lozar Manfreda is assistant professor of statistics and social informatics at the Faculty of Social Sciences at University of Ljubljana, Slovenia. She is interested especially in social science methodology, particularly in the methods of data collection using new information-communication technologies. Her research on survey methodology has focused on survey errors of web surveys, especially non-response, mode effect and questionnaire design effect. She teaches courses in statistics and social science methodology (survey methodology, questionnaire design, new technologies in social science research). She is one of the vice-presidents of RC 33 – Research Committee on Logic and Methodology at the International Sociological Association since 2002, and member of ESRA (European Survey Research Association) committee since 2005. Her recent publications include articles in scientific journals such as *New media & Society*, *Journal of Computer Mediated Communication*, and *International Journal of Electronic Commerce*.
