Peter Ph. Mohler is Director of ZUMA and its European Centre for Comparative Surveys (ECCS), a Director of GESIS (the German Social Science Infrastructure Institutes), professor at Mannheim University and a member of the German Council for Social- and Economic Data. Together with his colleagues of the Central Coordinating team of the European Social Survey, he received the 2005 Descartes Price of the European Union. As Program Director of the German part of the International Social Survey Programme (ISSP) he served for six years as its Secretary General. He taught at the Universities of Frankfurt, Heidelberg and Leipzig and gave courses at numerous institutions such as the Universities of Michigan, Alicante, Graz, or the European University Institute. His major research interests are comparative survey methodology and computer-assisted text analysis (TEXTPACK). His most recent publications are on comparative research, background demographics and survey documentation.
