

Rässler, Susanne

Susanne Rässler is head of the Competence Centre Empirical Methods of the Institute for Employment Research and head of the Department for Product and Program Analysis of the Federal Employment Agency in Germany. Additionally she serves as professor at the University of Erlangen-Nürnberg where she received her Ph.D. in statistics about survey sampling. In 2001 she finished her Habilitation in statistics and econometrics about data fusion procedures and got specialized in statistical matching. Susanne Rässler has published three books (on survey sampling, statistical matching, and prediction techniques) and a couple of papers touching very different topics. Her special interests are methods for handling missing data, multiple imputation, Bayesian methods, and matching techniques for causal analysis as well as marketing research. In her position at the Federal Employment Agency she is developing the German system for evaluation of active labour market policy based on Rubin's Causal Model.
