

Hox, Joop

Joop J. Hox is professor of social science methodology at the Department of Methodology and Statistics of the Faculty of Social Sciences at Utrecht University. He is a graduate of the University of Amsterdam, and was a Fulbright scholar at UCLA. His research interests focus on two lines of work: data quality in social surveys and multilevel modeling. In survey methodology, he has published on nonresponse problems and the effects of data collection mode and interviewers on various aspects of data quality. In multilevel modeling, he has written numerous articles, chapters and a monograph. He is the author of *Multilevel Analysis.
