

Lensvelt, Gerty

Dr. Gerty Lensvelt-Mulders is a senior researcher at the Methodology & Statistics Department of Utrecht University, the Netherlands. In 2000 she received her PhD in social sciences at Tilburg University. She started out as a researcher at the IVA, the institute for scientific research in the social sciences of Tilburg University; later she was assistant professor at Utrecht University, where she is currently working as associate professor.

Her main interest and publications are in the study of improving the quality of sensitive surveys in all phases of the research process. She is specialized in randomized response techniques, used as a tool to collect more valid sensitive data. More recently her research focus shifted to online-panel surveys and more specifically towards procedures that can enhance the external validity of non-random samples. Most of these procedures are propensity based, and her research centers on how researchers should anticipate these procedures

in the design phase. She works with government, business, and academic clients and regularly teaches short courses outside the university.
